GRAND HALL AND OCTAGONAL HALL

Our breath-taking Grand Hall is steeped in history and grandeur. Flooded with natural daylight, with a stunning lattice ceiling, this unique space is perfect for grand ceremonies, dinners and parties where you want to dance the night away.

The adjacent Octagonal Hall, with its mosaic floor and stained-glass dome ceiling, serves as an elegant choice for an intimate wedding ceremony or to serve welcome drinks before guests move into the Grand Hall.


